Farming4Hunger Outcomes Overview

As Farming4Hunger begins to map out some of the overarching desired outcomes for both the Second Chances and Youth programming, they have brainstormed some of the central themes (below). This can serve as a guide for your team in starting to build out more concrete outcomes and map out measurement and metrics.

Desired Overarching Short-Term (Learning) Outcomes

Second Chances: Men returning to society with increased social and emotional skills, better team and work ethics, and the potential to mentor youth in a positive direction.

Youth: Instilled hope, curiosity and interest in personal growth, healthier ways of living and alternative choices.

Desired Overarching Intermediate (Action) Outcome

Second Chances: Returning citizens employed within 3 months out of incarceration.

Youth: Beginning to trust the process, the farm and each other. Developing peer support groups.

Desired Overarching Long-Term (Conditions) Outcome

Second Chances: Reducing recidivism and increasing positive leadership with populations effected by incarceration.

Youth: Making better decisions.
